Richard is musical director of The Hythe Singers, Hampton Choral Society, Henley Choral Society, Henley Youth Choir and Parenthesis. He is Chorus Master at Opera Holland Park, singing lead at Beechview Academy, High Wycombe and a music teacher at Sir William Borlase Grammar School in Marlow. Richard also works extensively as an organist and accompanist, performing regularly with soprano Christine Cunnold. At Opera Holland Park Richard has worked on La Traviata, Eugene Onegin (Assistant Conductor & Chorus Master), Carmen, La Bohème, Don Giovanni, Cosi Fan Tutte, Le Nozze di Figaro; Manon Lescaut and Un Ballo in Maschera (Chorus Master), Pirates of Penzance (Chorus Master and Assistant Repetiteur). Other operatic engage-ments have included L'Elisir d'amore for West Green House Opera (Chorus Master), HMS Pinafore for Windsor and Eton Opera (Conductor), Terterian's Fire Ring at the Grimeborn Festival with London Armenian Opera (Conductor), Schumann-devised opera Unknowing and Menotti's The Telephone with Teatime Opera (Musical Director), and Jonathan Hervey's Passion and Resurrection at the Voices of London Festival (Conductor). Richard graduated with an MA in Choral Conducting from the Royal Academy of Music, receiving the Thomas Armstrong Prize. He read music at, and was organ scholar of Fitzwilliam College, Cambridge, where he received the Swinburne Prize. When not making music, he is usually found down his allotment or walking his cocker spaniel Louis.

Jaakko Mäntyjärvi is a professional freelance translator and composer, and also an amateur and semi-professional choral singer and conductor. He is one of Finland's internationally best-known composers of choral music, with a catalogue of some 150 works published to date.

Emma Lou Diemer (born in Kansas City, Missouri) is an American composer. She has written many works for orchestra, chamber ensemble, keyboard, voice, chorus, and electronic media.

Bert Reisfeld (1906-1991) / Rolf Marbot (1906-1974)

Mein Kleiner Grüner Kaktus *My Little Green Cactus* (*Sonnet 156*) **The Close Shaves** (David Moncur, Tony Dowson, Jason Crampton, Rüdiger Schack)

The composers Bert Reisfeld and Rolf Marbot, who emigrated to Paris in 1933, composed the melody for the French version of this popular song "J'aime une Tyrolienne" in 1934. The origin of this song was a puzzle to researchers until the discovery of a littleknown Shakespeare sonnet, which bears a strong narrative similarity to the song. The provenance of Sonnet 156 is disputed, but the textual link between the sonnet and the song is too obvious to be ignored.

The bell for death constantly tolls but no-one is so bold as to shed a vain tear for the suffering and dying. **Oppressed Homeland!** My Homeland! Oh Homeland!
